

CM 175 : Motion Graphics and 2D Animation

Introduces two-dimensional digital illustration, animation principles, and techniques for storytellers. Topics include drawing and manipulating objects, scaling and rotating, creating symbols, tweens, frame by frame animations, nested animations, and animating along a path. Additionally, lessons will include audio integration, synching and basic interactive elements. Projects will utilize the use of vector and raster images, typography and effects to create integrated visual effects and motion graphics for use in presentations, advertising, motion pictures, and animation.
